

Add the following to the General Rules in the Rule Book, Addendum A to the DFL Constitution and Bylaws:

Interpretations of Party Documents. Any member or group of members of the party may offer their advice on the interpretation of party rules and documents, however-. No such advice has binding authority. The concept of a “formal advisory opinion” does not exist. No Standing Committee, subordinate unit, or other committee of the DFL has binding authority to interpret party governing documents, that authority is vested solely with the Minnesota DFL highest governing bodies which includes the State Convention, and between State Convention the State Central Committee, and between State Central Committee Meetings the State Executive Committee as already prescribed by the DFL Constitution. Only these bodies can offer official interpretations of our party governing documents.
